

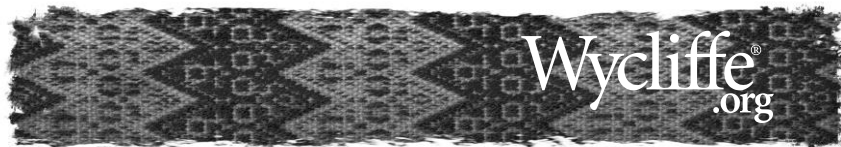

Now Lama Christians can read the Bible in their own language. One night a Lama Christian family sat outside to eat supper. The lights went out, and the night looked very dark. Then they all saw fireflies!



The daughter, Clarisse, jumped up,. Catching a firefly, she used its light to find matches and a lantern in the house. What had changed so that Clarisse no longer feared the firefly?



Answer: As a Christian, Clarisse acted on what the Bible teaches. She trusted that Jesus is stronger than any created thing! (Colossians 1:15-17)
