Twenty Questions

- 1) All religions point to the same God. (FALSE)
—There is one living and true God. All other “gods” are human creations, with neither substance nor power.
- 2) The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are one God, the same in substance, and equal in power and glory. (TRUE)
- 3) When a huge disc-shaped cloud of gas and dust particles came together, the earth was formed. (F)
—God called the earth and the entire universe into being, giving life to all living things.
- 4) By the word of His power, God made all things out of nothing in six days. (T)
- 5) God created Adam and Eve in His own perfect image: with knowledge, righteousness, holiness, and dominion over the animals. (T)
- 6) People evolved from very simple microorganisms over millions of years of time. (F)
—The Bible clearly teaches that God created people; He breathed life and spirit into human beings.
- 7) People can never really know why they exist. (F)
—All people exist for God’s pleasure.
- 8) The most important life-purpose of every person is to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever. (T)
- 9) “Sin” depends on a person’s cultural background or psychological conditioning. (F)
—“Sin” is missing God’s perfect standard—regardless of a person’s background or culture.
- 10) Sin is breaking any law of God, or behaving in ways that do not conform to the character of God. (T)
- 11) Jesus Christ is fully God (divine) and fully man (human). (T)
- 12) Christ became man by being conceived in the womb of the virgin Mary by the Holy Spirit, and born of her. (T)
- 13) During Jesus’ life on earth, Satan kept Jesus from using His divine abilities. (F)
—During Jesus’ earthly life, He voluntarily “emptied” Himself of many divine attributes and powers.
- 14) Christ humbled Himself on earth by being subject to the law and the hardships of life, and by dying on the cross. (T)
- 15) Someday, every person who ever lived will bow before Jesus and declare Him “Lord.” (T)
- 16) Christ exalted Himself by rising from the dead and ascending into heaven; he will come to judge the world at the last day. (T)
- 17) A person can get into heaven by doing many good works. (F)
—Heaven is a free gift that God gives to people by grace, based solely on their faith in Christ’s death on their behalf.
- 18) Jesus’ death and resurrection satisfied God’s requirement that people pay the debt for their own sins. (T)
- 19) God sets Christians apart from the world to accomplish His holy purposes. (T)
- 20) God empowers believers more and more to die to sin and live to righteousness. (T)
